**4-Lady Scramble – Each golfer hits a tee shot. The results of the tee shots are compared to determine which one is best. That ball is selected and marked and the other golfers on the team pick up their golf balls and move them to that location. The second shots are played and the process is repeated on the second shot, third shot, and so on until the ball is holed. When moving golf balls to the spot of the selected shot, the other golfers on the team can play from within one-club length of the original spot. The one-club length cannot be closer to the hole and cannot improve the lie of the original ball. That is, if the selected drive is in the rough, then the other team members must also play from the rough. You must play your golf ball within six inches of the original ball when on the putting green.**

**Shamble – A shamble is similar to a scramble to begin the hole. Each golfer hits a tee shot. The results of the tee shots are compared to determine which one is the best. That ball is selected and marked and the other golfers on the team pick up their golf balls and move them to that location. Everyone on the team will now play their own golf ball for the remainder of the hole.**

**Blind Partners – In Blind Partners, the golf shop will randomly choose 4-person teams. Each player will play their own ball for the 9-holes.**

**Proximity Contests – There will be proximity contests on every hole including, long drive, closest to hole, long putt, shortest drive, etc**

**3-Club Contest – Choose any three clubs in your bag to play your 9-hole round.**
